1 At the park, an adult you don't know asks if you can help him look for his lost puppy. What should you do?

- a. Tell him about your new puppy.
- b. Go with him to help.
- c. Check first. Tell a trusted adult what happened.



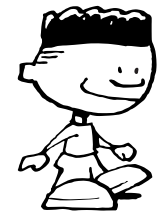
2 Something happens that makes you feel uncomfortable. Who is a trusted adult you could tell?

- a. Your teacher, parent or guardian.
- b. The first adult you can find.
- c. Your new neighbor, who you haven't met.



3 Your cousins are always rough when they play with you. You don't like it. What should you do?

- a. Don't say anything.
- b. Ask your friend to talk to them.
- c. Ask them to stop, and then tell your parent, guardian or other trusted adult.



4 A new neighbor who you don't know asks you to come inside for a snack. What should you do?

- a. Leave your yard and go into her house.
- b. Ask your parent or guardian if it's OK.
- c. Invite her to your house instead.

5 You have to create a password to play an online computer game. What should it be?

- a. Your birthday.
- b. Check first with a parent or guardian to create a password that does not reveal personal information about you, like your name and age or the name of your school.
- c. The same password as your best friend.

6 Your babysitter asks you to stay home alone while she goes to the store. Your parents don't let you stay home alone. What should you do?

- a. Tell her you can't and call your parents or guardian to tell them.
- b. Ask your little sister if it's OK.
- c. It's OK. She'll be back soon.

Answers: 1. C – Never accept rides or gifts from anyone you don't know. Tell a trusted adult if this happens. 2. A – Tell a trusted adult if anyone or anything makes you feel scared, uncomfortable or confused. 3. C – It's OK to say NO to any unwelcome, uncomfortable or confusing touch or actions by others. 4. B – Always check with a parent or guardian before you go anywhere. Never go anywhere with someone you don't know. 5. B – Never give any personal information such as your name, address or phone number to people you don't know. 6. A – Always follow your family rules, and tell a parent or guardian if someone asks you not to.
